ORDER

On February 3, 2014, Plaintiff Gregory Lott filed a motion for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction. (ECF No. 418.) Pursuant to S. D. Ohio Civ. R. 65.1(a), the Court therefore held an informal preliminary telephone conference with the relevant parties on February 4, 2014.

As a result of discussions held at that conference, the Court **ORDERS**:

(1) The motion for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction shall come on for an oral hearing on February 19, 2014, at 8:30 a.m. Each side shall have three hours and one-half hours to present its case, with Plaintiff proceeding at 8:30 a.m. and Defendants proceeding at 1:00 p.m.

(2) The parties shall confer in an effort to identify and arrange witnesses and agree on stipulations. Any stipulations must be in writing and presented to the Court no later than the end of the February 19, 2014 hearing.

(3) The parties shall work together to coordinate expedited discovery. The parties may conduct depositions if possible. In the event of a discovery dispute, the parties shall contact the Court immediately for a telephone conference.

(4) In light of the expedited schedule, no expert reports need be exchanged, although the

parties must identify any experts on or before February 12, 2014.

(5) Defendants may file a memorandum in opposition on or before February 14, 2014.

No reply memorandum is permitted. No post-hearing briefing is permitted unless requested by the Court.

(6) If either party will present hearing testimony by video conference, that party must contact Chambers prior to 12:00 p.m. on February 14, 2014, to coordinate logistics.
